ACTIVITY REPORT (2019-20)

25.08.2019 (07.00 AM to 12.00 PM)

“Swachh Mijar”, a cleaning operation in the locality was organized by the NSS unit of AIET, in association with the Gram Panchayt of Tenkamijaru, Samskruthika Kala Vedike-Ashwathapura, Javaner Bedra and other local organizations. Among the nine centers adopted by AIET under the “Swachh Mijar Campaign”, cleaning activities were carried out in two, viz., Ashwathapura and Neerkere and created awareness about the need for maintaining cleanliness. 82 students alongwith program officer Mr. Suresh P S, faculty coordinator Mr. Sandeep Kumar D S (CV Dept.) actively participated in the event.



08.09.2019 (08.00 AM to 03.00 PM)

Blood donation camp was organized by Samskruthika Kala Vedike – Ashwathapura, Spandana Sahakara Bandhu and various organizations including AIET, at Ashwathapura. More than 65 units of blood were collected in the camp by KMC – Mangalore. Besides the above, separate programmes (i) for the issuance of “Ayushman Card” which assure health cover up to Rs.5.00 Lakhs and (ii) for availing benefits available for building and other construction workers, were also conducted. More than 200 residents enrolled for the health care scheme and more than 45 building and other construction workers have registered their names to avail the benefits.
