

I N Rai, Flt Lt B R Shetty and many other veterans of ex-servicemen team in coordination with 53 Alva's NCC Air wing cadets, one ANO and 47 NSS students took part in the event.

The main purpose of the campaign was to create awareness among the student of various schools and colleges of the village. Under this programme, we all took Oath of keeping our home, locality and city clean by spending 100 hours in a year that is 2 hours per week for the cleanliness of the society.

SwamiJitakamanandaji, chief guest of the inaugural function addressed the students and cadets and motivated them to be the ambassadors of change and make entire society aware about importance of swacchta.

- 1. Locals have complaint about toilet facility should be built at the yedapadu public area.
- 2. Locals complaints that municipal vehicle to collect garbage does not reach their houses.
- 3. The water purifier facility built at the public place of yadapadu, never opened at all, claimed by the locals.

#### 3. CAMPAIGN ON DIGITAL PAYMENTS & TRANSACTIONS ON 07 OCT 2018

On 07/10/2018, a Social activity was conducted in the Mijar village on Digital Payments. The main aim of this activity was to create awareness among the local people about how they could transact money digitally using various apps like Paytm, Google Pay, BHIM, PhonePay and credit cards. Total of 15 Air wing cadets, led by CdtSgtApoorva including 1<sup>st</sup> years, 2<sup>nd</sup> years and 3<sup>rd</sup> years have taken part in this activity. These cadets have covered about 20 houses and shops around the Mijar Village. The locals where given an exposure about how there would not be any hard cash in a few years and most of the transactions would be done digitally. They were also given an idea of how these apps would save time and also that it would be safer than keeping too much money in hand. The cadets gave them an awareness of how to use these apps and also showed them demos practically and also made them understand that online payment is free of cost. It took almost 3 hours to cover as many houses and shops as possible and interacts with the people. Cadets have motivated many people, especially the shopkeepers to install and make use of the various opportunities that digital payment methods give them.






