

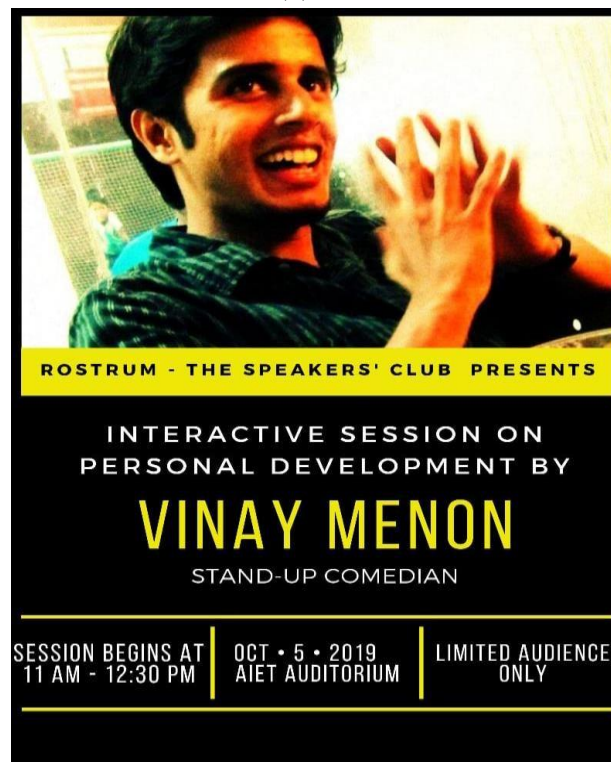



INTRODUCTION OF THE GUEST:

Nitte Santosh Hegde (born 16 June 1940) is a former judge of the Supreme Court Of India, former Solicitor General of India and was Lokayukta (ombudsman) for Karnataka State of India from 2006-2011. Santosh Hegde was born in a Tulu-speaking Tuluva Bunt family to former judge of Supreme Court, Justice K. S. Hegde and his wife Meenakshi Hegde (née Adyanthaya). He is one of six children born to the couple. He was born on 16 June 1940 in Nitte, Udupi district, Karnataka. He had his early education at St. Aloysius College, Mangalore and Madras Christian College in Madras. He completed his intermediate exam from St. Joseph's College, Bangalore and BSc degree from Central College of Bangalore. Hegde graduated with a law degree from Government Law College (now known as University Law College), Bangalore in 1965. Mr. Justice N. Santosh Hegde was born on June 16, 1940.

He graduated in law in 1965 and after completing apprenticeship training was enrolled as an Advocate in January, 1966 and designated as senior Advocate in May, 1984. He was appointed as

the Advocate General for the State of Karnataka in February, 1984 and held that position till August, 1988. He worked as Additional Solicitor General of the Union of India from December, 1989 to November, 1990. He was re-appointed as the Solicitor General of India on April 25, 1998. Appointed as a Judge of Supreme Court of India on 8.1.1999. Retired on 16.6.2005. He was appointed as Lokayukta of Karnataka state on 3 August 2006 for a term of five years. He retired as Lokayukta of Karnataka on 2 August 2011. Subsequently, he joined the anti-corruption movement launched by Anna Hazare in 2011 as a core member of Team Anna. In August 2012, he left Team Anna and refused to be part of it after the team decided to go political.

REPORT

This guest talk had 1100 students from various colleges of the foundation. The guest spoke about various things related to the topic i.e. the corruption in the country, mass communication (news channels) leaving their work ethics, media channel being tilted towards the political power, improper measurements taken by the government in administration, roads are not constructed even after the permission is granted, effect of social media in the public and youths, all these things are making humans to forget humanism and morality in them. The Question and Answer session went on for 45min. Some of the questions were as such, is there nepotism in administration, are adultery laws only against men, why reservation system still exists in education and competitive exams and so on. He also gave an important message to the students that don't be corrupted or don't bribe to anyone, always be honest in your work and life.



INTRODUCTION OF THE GUEST:

Dr. C.R. Chandrashekar is a senior faculty member of National Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences, Bangalore since 1975. In addition to his responsibilities of teaching, training and research, he has been actively involved in dissemination of information about mental health, hospitals, health professionals, treatment methods, etc., with the objective of stimulating scientific temper, dispelling misconceptions and including correct attitude towards mental disorders. He is a regular columnist in 'Mangala', a Kannada weekly and has written over 850 popular science articles in different magazines and periodicals. He has published 96 books in Kannada and 15 in English, several of these books have been translated into Urdu and Telugu. He is a sought-after speaker by medical, educational, industrial and non-governmental institutions and has conducted

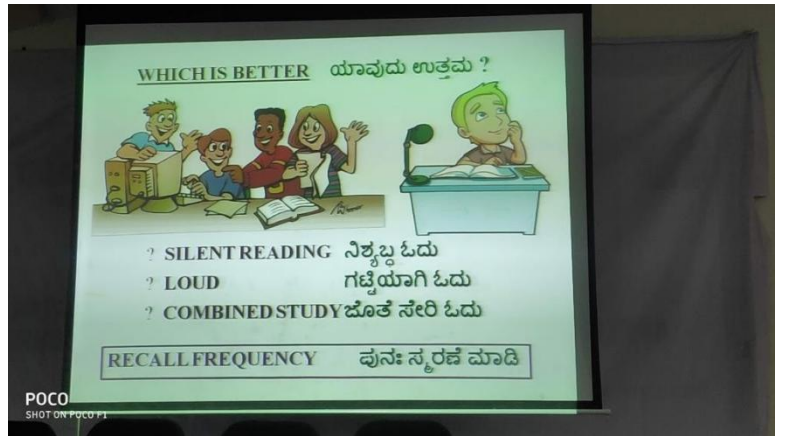
over 100 discussions/dialogues every year and has delivered over 1000 popular science lectures. He has given talks over radio and interviews on television on different aspects of behavioral sciences

REPORT

"I was approached by an NGO which asked me to train their grassroots level volunteers in counselling," he said. "I rose to the challenge at once." That led to his founding the Prasanna Centre in Basavanagudi in 1980, where he offered free medical help, held workshops on stress management and the importance of mental health. He even developed a training module for lay counselling, which is open to anybody who wishes to make a difference. "Our only condition is that they provide services on a volunteer basis and not use their skills to make a profit," he said. So far, he has trained over 5000 lay counsellors and 2000 teachers in student counselling as well. Samadhana, he says, aspires to be a safe space, one that people can approach without being encumbered by the stigma that is still attached to seeking out mental healthcare professionals. "People are still hesitant to approach centres like NIMHANS, that's what prompted me to start Samadhana in the first place." How does he achieve this? "Through education, of course," he said promptly. He uses his proclivity for writing to spread awareness in a society steeped in superstition. "I give workshops and talks and demonstrate, as far as possible, that counselling interventions work. People come to me on their own now, asking for help."




