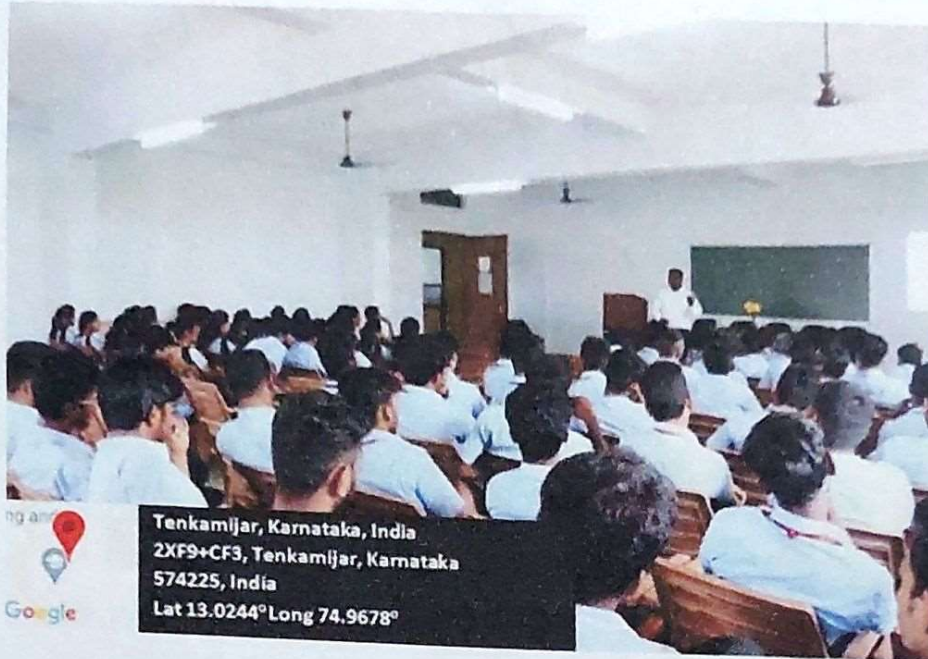
PROGRAMME PROCEEDINGS:


