Alva's Institute of Engineering and Technology's MBA department organised a 4-day industrial visit from January 21st to 24th, 2023, for final-year MBA students, focusing on enhancing practical knowledge and exposing students to real-world working conditions. The primary objective was to provide students with insights into business operations and foster exposure to current industry practices.

The visit centred around TVS Motor Company in Mysore, a multinational motorcycle company and the thirdlargest in India. The company, with a revenue exceeding ₹15,000 crores, annually produces 3 million units and exports to over 60 countries. During the visit, 58 second-year MBA students and 2 faculty members toured the plant under the supervision of plant managers and senior engineers. The students were briefed on the company's history, achievements, and then divided into teams for a guided tour of the facility. The tour included exposure to various types of machines, efficiency improvement techniques, and employee management. Strict safety protocols were followed, and a Q&A session allowed students to engage with industry experts. The visit concluded with a vote of thanks, a photo session, and lunch.

PG Department of Business Administration organised a visit to the Channapatna Toy Factory, with 116 MBA students in attendance. The journey began at 9:30 AM, reaching the factory in Channapatna at 10:30 AM, offering practical exposure and insights from the Director.

Channapatna, known as the "Toy City" of Karnataka, is famous for its handmade lacquer wooden toys. The craft, with a Geographical Indication (GI) tag, has evolved to include various woods. Manufacturing involves wood procurement, shaping, carving, colouring with vegetable dyes, and polishing. Challenges faced by the industry were addressed through support from KHDC, government assistance, and initiatives from new companies.

Special features of Channapatna toys include their 200-year-old handmade tradition, use of edible colours for safety, absence of pointed edges, and recycling of wood waste for incense. Notably, these toys have gained global recognition, even reaching the White House and being gifted to Microsoft employees. The visit provided valuable practical exposure, concluding at 2:00 PM.

#### AMS, Mysore

PG Department of Business Administration, guided by Mrs. Priya Sequeira, Mrs. Catherine, and Mr. Guruprasad Pai, visited AMS Manufacturing Industry during their 5-day industry visit. The company specialises in manufacturing machines, achieving ISO standards and total quality management certification, with a global market presence, notably in Germany and the USA.



The 117 students were divided into two groups, receiving instructions from the employee head and team leaders. AMS emphasised their unique organisational culture, including daily yoga sessions for all 1500-plus employees, individual Kanban introductions, and a focus on diversification into customised machines.

The visit concluded with a discussion with HR and Finance team leaders, showcasing a company video and addressing student queries. The day ended with a vote of thanks and feedback from PG students.
